

Prayer Six: Breakthrough

1. Who knows what's on Your heart, O Lord? We declare, "We do, and so does YOUR Church—the Bride who is *making herself ready*." We stand in amazement at You, our Bridegroom and King. We trust You for the final outcome that zero fall through the cracks and that our hearts and goals aligns with Your Word *that none would perish but all come to the saving knowledge of Jesus*.

"How great is our God; You alone are worthy of all our praise and adoration!" Idols become non-existent.
