### WHAT'S HAPPENING?

- Mobilization of 153 prayer teams to pray for and visit every household in the city
- 40 Days of Prayer for Loganville: June 17th – July 26th
- Youth groups practically serving those in need: July 14th – 18th
- 24 Hour Prayer Gathering: 8pm July 25th – 8pm July 26th
- Festival featuring performances from local church youth bands, food, fun and information booths featuring area churches and ministries: Saturday, July 26th, 4-9pm

- Join in 40 Days of Prayer, starting with a kick-off gathering on June 17th. (This gathering will also serve as an informational meeting for prayer team leaders and participants.)
- Join with other prayer teams to worship, pray and share testimonies before and after house visits on July 5th, 15th and 17th.
- Take a prayer shift during the 24-Hour Prayer Gathering, July 25th – 26th
- Host an informational booth, volunteer and/or help sponsor the July 26th festival.
- Let us know if you have other ideas that we may be able to help implement!
